Mr. President,

My delegation categorically rejects Japanese ~~allegations~~ <sup>remarks</sup> on past crimes as well as abduction case.

First, the systematic military sexual slavery carried out by Japanese government and military has not been resolved even at this new century.

The so-called "apology" or "remorse" <sup>to talk about</sup> by the Japanese are only a lip service aimed at misleading the people.

Second, the so-called resolution <sup>of DPRK</sup> as referred to by Japan is the product of tricky conspiracy by some including Japan only to defame ~~the~~ the DPRK. That is why we denounce and reject it.

Third, the Japanese abduction case has been resolved fundamentally and completely. There's nothing else.

Japanese distortion as if this case were outstanding is based on its ulterior political agenda pursued as part of its hostility against the DPRK.

Fourth, Japan is the only country in the world that has never settled its past war crimes and crimes against humanity <sup>including 8.4 million abduction and drafting, 1 million genocidal killing and 200,000 military sexual slavery</sup>.

Japan has never ~~settled~~ settled it. It is even trying to deny it.

Most recently, current Japanese Prime Minister said Japan could neither admit nor apologize for ~~among other things~~ sexual slavery.

Japan's past ~~is~~ full of blood and human rights violations <sup>the rights</sup> ~~that have not been resolved~~ still remains outstanding due to reluctance of the Japanese government.

In conclusion, Mr. President, we strongly urge Japan to immediately stop its political games on ~~the abduction case~~ abduction case and settle all its past crimes.
