Elaboration of complementary standards to the International Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Racial Discrimination

The Human Rights Council,

Recalling its decision 3/103 of 8 December 2006 on the elaboration of complementary standards to the International Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Racial Discrimination and the creation of the Ad Hoc Committee for this purpose,

Underlining the imperative need for the Ad Hoc Committee on the Elaboration of Complementary Standards to the ICERD to accomplish its mandate, in accordance with paragraph 199 of the Durban Programme of Action.

to elaborate the legal instruments required to complement and fill the existing substantive gaps in the Convention in order to strengthen and update international instruments against racism, racial discrimination, xenophobia and related intolerance in all their aspects,

Underlining also the need for the Ad Hoc Committee to accomplish-its mandate,

- 1. Takes not with appreciation of the report of the Chairperson-Rapporteur of Requests the Ad Hoc Committee on the elaboration of complementary standards to the ICERDelaborate additional protocols to the International Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Racial Discrimination in a structured manner;
- 2. Decides that the Ad Hoc Committee shall convene its third session from 30 November to 10 December 2010;
- 3. Requests the Chairperson Rapporteur of the Ad-Hoc Committee to prepare, on the basis of inputs already received, a draft additional protocol on cybercrime for negotiations scheduled to commence at its third session;
 - 4. Decides also to remain seized of this priority issue.
